**DECISION AND ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, PROTECTING  
CONFIDENTIALITY, AND DISMISSING CLAIM WITH PREJUDICE**

The parties to the above-captioned proceeding have submitted a Request For Withdraw Of Claim, Motion For Approval Of Settlement Agreement And Nondisclosure Agreement And Notice of Dismissal With Prejudice ("Agreement").

A hearing by telephone was held on the Agreement on February 21, 2008. Complainant, who is proceeding *pro se*, stated that he entered into the Agreement of his own volition and without duress. After consideration of the terms of the agreement, it is determined that the Agreement is fair, reasonable, and in the public interest.

The parties jointly request that the settlement agreement and files related to this matter be treated as confidential under all applicable exemptions of the Freedom of Information Act or other applicable laws.

**ORDER**

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed Settlement Agreement and General Release is approved, that the record of this proceeding is treated as confidential information pursuant to 29 C.F.R. §70.26, that the withdraw of the complaint and this appeal is

approved, and that the claim is dismissed with prejudice and with each party to bear their own attorney fees and costs.
