ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arises under the temporary agricultural labor or services provision of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), and its implementing regulations at 20 C.F.R. § 655, Part B.

On March 24, 2004, the Employment Training Administration, having considered Employer's application requesting H-2A temporary alien labor certification for four job opportunities, granted certification for three job opportunities and denied certification for one. Employer requested a review of the denial by an administrative law judge, and the matter was referred to this Office on April 7, 2004. By letter dated April 8, 2004, the Employment Training Administration granted certification for all four job opportunities, and advised that this determination supersedes the one made on March 24, 2004 partially certifying Employer's application. Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the administrative review, being moot, is **DISMISSED**, and this matter is marked **CLOSED**.
