**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The above-referenced matter arises under the temporary agricultural labor or services provision of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), and its implementing regulations, found at 20 C.F.R. § 655, Part B.

On January 9, 2006, Global Horizons, Inc. submitted an application requesting H-2A temporary alien labor certification for 9 Farmworker, Grain II job opportunities in Kauai, Hawaii. Upon denial of this application, Global Horizons, Inc. requested a hearing de novo before an administrative law judge. The case was assigned to the undersigned and scheduled for hearing in Long Beach, California on March 3, 2006.

By letter dated February 27, 2006, Global Horizons has advised that the parties have resolved the dispute and Employer's application was accepted and certified on February 24, 2006.

The hearing scheduled to commence at **10:00 AM on Friday, March 3, 2006, in Room 5150 at the Long Beach Federal Building, 501 West Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, California**, is hereby **VACATED**

Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the Request for Hearing, being moot, is **DISMISSED** and this matter is marked **CLOSED**.
