Order of Dismissal

Global Horizons, Inc., and Mordechai Orian requested a *de novo* hearing on the denial of their application for temporary alien agricultural certification for 15 workers to tend and pollinate seed production crops, including corn and soybeans, for Pioneer Hi-Bred International Inc. in Waimea, Kauai, Hawaii. The Employment and Training Administration accepted the application (Case No. C-06299-03202), but denied it because the applicants have been debarred from the H-2A program for a period of three years. Their motion to stay that debarment was denied on December 26, 2006.

There is no issue for trial, the debarment prevents the certifications sought. The request for hearing is dismissed.
