ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 11, 2008, the Office of Administrative Law Judges (OALJ) received the Employer's request for expedited administrative judicial review on the denial of its H-2A application for temporary alien labor certification in the above-referenced matter. *See* 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B. On May 27, 2008, OALJ received a letter from counsel for the Certifying Officer stating that "[u]pon further consideration, the CO has determined that the application for temporary labor certification submitted by Knapp Farms (KF) complies with the pertinent requirements. Therefore, the CO will accept the employer's application for processing." The

letter indicated that Knapp Farms had been informed of this determination and concurred in the result. The letter indicated that no further proceedings before the OALJ would be required.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the appeal in the above-captioned matter is hereby **DISMISSED**.
