ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

On March 27, 2009, the Certifying Officer (“the CO”) filed a letter requesting remand. Therein, the CO explained that, after conferring with St. Louis Select Landscaping and Lawn Care (“the Employer”), he has concluded that he will grant the Employer’s application for temporary labor certification. Later that day, the Employer filed a document that contained several stipulations. The Employer requested that the CO note and confirm these stipulations. On March 30, 2009, the CO filed a letter rejecting the proposed stipulations. The CO explained that, after discussing the matter, the Employer would like me to grant the CO’s remand request. In light of the foregoing, the Certifying Officer’s request is hereby **GRANTED**, and this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer to grant certification. **SO ORDERED.**
