ORDER SCHEDULING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

Pursuant to the provisions of 41 C.F.R. Section 60-30.7, a pre-hearing conference is hereby scheduled in the above-captioned matter. The conference will commence at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 21, 1994 at the Office of Administrative Law Judges, 525 Vine Street, Suite 900, Cincinnati, Ohio.

The purpose of the conference will be to:

1. Codify each of the issues involved in this case;
2. Discuss a comprehensive stipulation of facts and documents;
3. Exchange general views as to the evidence to be produced in proving each of the issues mentioned in Item 1 above;
4. Identify generally the documentary evidence to be offered by each party with respect to the issues mentioned in Item 1 above.
5. Identify potential witnesses;
6. Discuss the possibility of negotiation, compromise, or settlement of issues;
7. Discuss potential evidentiary and discovery problems;
8. Discuss the law as it relates to the applicable burden of proof;

9. Set a schedule to be followed by the parties for completion of the actions decided at the conference;
10. Agree to a date for the commencement of the hearing of this case; and
11. Discuss other matters which may expedite and aid in the disposition of this case.

This conference will serve as a prelude to the scheduling of this case for hearing early in 1995.
