ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART
GRANT OFFICER'S MOTION FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER

In accordance with 29 C.F.R. §18.15, the Grant Officer moved for a protective order limiting the Center for Employment Training's ("CET") discovery in this case. Two conferences with counsel were held to discuss this motion, on October 3 and 5, 1983, and at the latter conference an oral order was issued in which the motion was granted in part and denied in part. The terms of that order are as follows:

1. The Grant Officer shall disclose the names and job titles of the members of the reviewing panels concerning both the Colorado and California programs. The Grant Officer also shall identify the alphabetical designation given to each panel member on the rating sheets.

2. Depositions of the Colorado panel members and the Grant Officer shall be permitted, limited to the six areas of inquiry delineated by CET in its Opposition to Grant Officer's Motion For Protective Order.

3. The Grant Officer shall turn over the panel members' rating sheets and chairperson's Summary Sheet for CET in regard to the California program. In addition, any other report or summary by the panel, or by its chairperson on behalf of the panel, which evaluates the proposals for the California program shall be turned over, but information or comments relating to applicants other than CET may be deleted.
