DISMISSAL

The Contracting Officer has moved that the appeal be dismissed as moot because of the following facts:

(1) His original final decision, dated September 17, 1984, disallowed a total of \$19,016 in costs under Contract No. JCC-15-6-0005 on the basis that Appellant failed to provide sufficient documentation to support those costs.

(2) On November 9, 1984, Appellant provided him with the required documentation relating to the disallowed costs, and based on that documentation, he issued a Revised Final Decision on February 20, 1985 allowing the entire amount of \$19,016 which had previously been disallowed.

Based upon the foregoing, it is clear that an actual dispute between the parties no longer exists, and accordingly the appeal is hereby dismissed as being moot.
