**ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS AND EXTENDING TIME  
FOR FILING APPEAL FILE**

Three contract appeals relating to the Grofton Job Corps Center, Contract E-4388-4-00-8220, are presently pending before a panel of this Board consisting of Judge Miller as lead judge and Judge Levin. The first appeal was filed on January 26, 1996, and docketed by order dated February 8, 1996, as 96-BCA-2. The second appeal, noticed in chronological order as claim Amendment #1 was filed with this Board on August 30, 1996, and has been docketed by order dated February 18, 1997, as 96-BCA-7. The third appeal, noticed as claim Amendment #2, was filed December 18, 1996, and docketed by order dated January 10, 1997, as 97-BCA-2. The parties have indicated that the appeals should be consolidated for hearing and other purposes. By letter dated February 10, 1997, the Contracting Officer requested a stay of the provision in the Prehearing Order dated January 10, 1997, relating to 97-BCA-2, so that it and 96-BCA-7 can be consolidated with 96-BCA-2, and so that the "Administrative Files" or Appeal Files may be paginated consecutively and in chronological sequences. The Contracting Officer represents that it would than file a motion to consolidate the three appeals, and that Appellant does not oppose the request. Wherefore, it is

**ORDERED** sua sponte that these three appeals be consolidated for management and hearing. The respective Appeal Files relative to 96-BCA-7 and 97-BCA-2 shall be filed in convenient and sequential form as appropriate, not later than March 31, 1997. All filings hereafter shall be captioned with all three docket numbers and shall be filed by original only with the Board.
