ORDER STAYING FINAL ACTION

Now before me is an application by the American Indian Center, Inc., for a stay of implementation of the Administrative Law Judge's decision issued on April 26, 1982, in the above-captioned matter pending review of that decision by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.

Upon consideration of the matter, I am persuaded that the request should be granted.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED:

1. That the above-referenced decision is STAYED pending review of it by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit; and
2. That the stay IS CONDITIONED UPON the submission by the American Indian Center, Inc., to the U.S. Department of Labor, within 30 days of the date of issuance of this Order, of a supersedeas bond for the amount (\$55,773.44) which the American Indian Center, Inc., was directed by the Administrative Law Judge to repay to the Department, and for such further amount as may accrue in interest due during the pendency of said review, at the interest

rate(s) which this Department would normally charge for delayed payment of the principal amount during that period.


