REMAND ORDER

Now before me is an Opinion of the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the matter of Affiliation of Arizona Indian Centers, Inc. v. United States Department of Labor, No. 82-7506, filed June 30, 1983, concerning the final decision of the Secretary of Labor in the above-captioned matter (i.e., the Decision and Order of Administrative Law Judge Glenn Robert Lawrence in the matter, issued on June 7, 1982).

In its Opinion (Appendix A hereto), the court remands the case to the Secretary to determine the applicability of 20 CFR 676.88(c), and to determine the actual amount of shared costs, if any. The Opinion states that "[o]n remand the Secretary is instructed to take evidence and make findings which ascertain the actual amount of shared costs, if any."

Accordingly, in view of the court's instruction that, on remand, evidence be taken, this matter is remanded to the Office of Administrative Law Judges for further proceedings and determinations pursuant to the court's Opinion.
