REMAND ORDER

Now before me, in regard to the above captioned matter are: (1) a Motion to Stay the Decision of the ALJ; (2) a Brief in Support of Said Motion; and (3) a Resistance to the Motion to Stay the Order of the ALJ.

A hearing of the above-captioned matter was held on June 13, 1984 before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Rhea Burrow. At the close of the hearing, the ALJ granted the parties 60 days after the release of the transcript to submit written briefs and arguments. The transcript of that hearing was received by the ALJ on July 2, 1984, but not until August 24, 1984 by the Complainant. The ALJ entered his decision prior

to the expiration date granted to the parties apparently believing that they had also received the transcript in early July. Since the prematurely entered decision precluded an opportunity for the Complainant to submit her written brief and argument, the entering of the decision by the ALJ was in error.

Accordingly, it is Ordered that the above-captioned matter IS REMANDED to the Office of the Administrative Law Judges for further action consistent with this Order; that the parties hereto be permitted adequate time to submit written briefs and arguments to ALJ Burrow to assist him in his decision.
