ORDER GRANTING STAY

Now before me is a request by counsel for the Chippewa Cree Tribe that I stay implementation of the final decision in the above-captioned matter (in which the tribe is ordered **to pay** a sum of money to the U.S. Department of Labor) pending direct review of that decision by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is Ordered that --


1. Implementation of the above-referenced decision IS STAYED pending review of it by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit; and that

2. The stay IS CONDITIONED UPON submission by the Tribe to the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL), within **30** days of the issuance of this Order, of a written agreement by the Tribe that, within 30 days after the Court of Appeals issuance of a decision favorable to the **USDOL**, the Tribe shall pay

to the USDOL in cash the principal amount determined by the Court to be owed to the USDOL, and such further amount as may accrue in interest during the **pendency** of said review, at the interest rate(s) which the USDOL would normally charge for delayed payment of the principal amount during that period.


