
FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

On May 23, 1988, I issued an Order to Show Cause ordering the parties to show cause within 10 days of their receipt of that order why the March 8, 1988, Recommended Decision and Order of Administrative Law Judge (**ALJ**) Glenn Robert Lawrence should not be the Secretary's final action in this case.

The time allowed for response has expired and no response has been received.

Accordingly, the **ALJ's** Recommended Decision and Order in this case which allowed \$146,502 of disallowed costs by the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc., made pursuant to its grants under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 501-999 (Supp. V. 1981), and which dismissed the Department of Labor's disallowance with prejudice, IS AFFIRMED.
