**ORDER OF DISMISSAL
AND ORDER CANCELLING HEARING**

This matter, which arises under the whistleblower provision of the Affordable Care Act. *See* 29 U.S.C. § 218c, is currently set for hearing on March 10, 2015, in Chicago, Illinois. On December 18, 2014, I received a letter from Complainant stating, in relevant part: “I am voluntarily and without condition withdrawing my OSHA complaint against NORC....” I am considering this letter a request to withdraw the complaint pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 1984.111(c).

As of January 5, 2015, I have received no response to Complainant’s filing from Respondent.

Accordingly, good cause appearing, Complainant’s request to withdraw the complaint is **GRANTED**. Case No. 2014-ACA-00002 is hereby **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**. All pending dates are vacated, and the hearing currently set for Tuesday, March 10, 2015 in Chicago, Illinois, is **CANCELLED**. Each party shall bear his or its own attorney’s fees and costs.
