**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On September 19, 2012, I issued an Order to Show Cause, noting that in a previous Order, issued on May 31, 2012, I granted the Complainant's request for a continuance of the hearing scheduled to take place on June 6 and 7, 2012. The Complainant had requested a continuance of 90 to 180 days, due to health problems, and I directed him to advise the Court no later than August 31, 2012 as to whether and when his health would permit him to attend a hearing, as well as the location he requested for a hearing. Having received no information from the Complainant in response to my May 31, 2012 Order, and attempts by my law clerk to contact the Complainant having been unsuccessful, I issued my September 19, 2012 Order directing the Complainant, within three weeks from the date of the Order, to show cause as to why his claim should not be dismissed as abandoned. The Complainant has not submitted any response to my Order.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complainant's complaint is dismissed as abandoned.
