ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AND DISMISSING CLAIM

This matter arises under the Wendell H. Ford Aviation Investment and Reform Act for the 21st Century (AIR 21), which was signed into law on April 5, 2000. AIR 21 includes a whistleblower protection provision, with a Department of Labor complaint procedure. *See* 49 U.S.C. § 42121. Implementing regulations are at 29 C.F.R. Part 1979.

On December 30, 2019, the parties provided a copy of the fully executed Settlement Agreement for approval.

The proposed Settlement Agreement is fair and reasonable as to the claims under the Wendell H. Ford Aviation Investment and Reform Act for the 21st Century. None of the terms are against the public interest. The proposed Settlement Agreement is APPROVED, and the parties are ORDERED to comply with its terms.

This matter is DISMISSED with prejudice. The hearing in this matter is hereby CANCELLED.
