**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND  
ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING CASE**

On March 4, 2015, I issued an Order directing the parties to show cause, within fourteen days, as to why the Complainant's complaint should not be dismissed as moot, and this matter administratively closed. I noted that I had previously issued an Order on January 27, 2009, directing the Complainant to show cause as to why these proceedings should not be stayed in light of the Respondent's pending bankruptcy proceeding. I did not receive a response, and on February 24, 2009, I issued an Order staying the proceedings in this matter pending resolution of the Bankruptcy Court proceedings. I directed the Respondent to advise the Court as to any actions in that matter that affected the proceedings in this case.

There has been no correspondence from the Complainant or Respondent since I issued my February 24, 2009 Order, nor any response to my March 4, 2015 Order to Show Cause. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complainant's complaint in this matter is hereby dismissed as moot, and this matter is administratively closed.
