**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE AND
CANCELLING HEARING**

This proceeding arises from a complaint of discrimination filed under the Energy Reorganization Act (“the ERA”), 42 U.S.C. § 5851 (2005). On July 13, 2018, the Complainant filed a stipulation of dismissal. On July 23, 2018, I held a telephonic conference to determine whether there was any adjudicative settlement involved with the dismissal. During the call, Complainant’s counsel Alan A. Kabat, Esq., confirmed there was no settlement and it was the Complainant’s voluntary action to dismiss his complaint at his time. Upon consideration of the stipulation and comments of counsel at the conference, it is ORDERED that:

- (1) The Stipulation of Dismissal is APPROVED;
- (2) The Complaint of Bassem Haddad is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE;
and
- (3) The trial set for December 4, 2018 in Omaha, Nebraska is CANCELLED.
