**ORDER CANCELLING HEARING, APPROVING WITHDRAWAL
OF COMPLAINT AND DISMISSAL OF CASE**

This proceeding arises under the employee protection provisions of the Federal Rail Safety Act of 2007 (“FRSA”), Title 49 United States Code § 20109, and the regulations promulgated thereunder at 29 C.F.R. Part 1982, and is currently scheduled for hearing on August 19, 2015, in Chicago, Illinois. On August 6, 2015, Complainant’s counsel submitted the parties’ Stipulation of Withdrawal and Dismissal with Prejudice, in which Complainant states that he “hereby voluntarily withdraws and dismisses with prejudice the above-referenced action.” Both parties are represented by counsel. No final decision has been issued in the matter. As such, upon review of the entire record, and for good cause shown, Complainant’s request to withdraw his September 26, 2013 complaint, currently pending before the Office of Administrative Law Judges, is hereby **GRANTED**. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the hearing in the instant case scheduled for August 19, 2015, in Chicago, Illinois is **CANCELLED**; and

Consistent with the regulations, the above captioned matter is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice, without costs awarded to either party.
