ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 2, 2017, Mr. John D. Coffman ("Complainant") filed a *Notice of Whistleblower Complaint* with the U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") against CSX Transportation, Inc., ("Respondents"). On August 11, 2017, OSHA issued its investigation report in the above captioned matter. In brief, OSHA found no reasonable cause to believe Respondent violated 49 U.S.C. § 20109. After the OSHA investigation, Complainant filed a request for a *de novo* hearing in this matter on September 5, 2017. On March 6, 2018, Complainant requested a voluntary dismissal without prejudice in this matter.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
