ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

This proceeding arises from a complaint of discrimination filed under the Federal Rail Safety Act (“the FRSA”), 49 U.S.C. § 20109 (2008). Trial is currently set for April 24, 2018 in Omaha, Nebraska. On December 8, 2017, the parties filed an Agreed Order of Dismissal. I will treat this document as a motion to dismiss. On December 14, 2017, I conducted a telephonic hearing on the Motion on the record. The parties indicated there was no settlement and the Claimant stated he no longer wanted to pursue his claim. Based on the representations of the parties, the Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 1982.111(c). It is ORDERED that:

The Complaint of Lawrence Rudolph, 2017-FRS-00101 is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
