**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT**

This is a claim under the employee-protection provisions of the Federal Railroad Safety Act, 49 U.S.C. § 20109, as amended by Section 1521 of the Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007, Pub. L. No. 110-53 (Aug. 3, 2007). It is currently set for hearing in Fresno, California, on July 2, 2018.

The parties jointly submit for court approval their “Settlement Agreement and Release of All Claims” (the “agreement”). Under the agreement, the parties settle this matter, Respondent paying \$20,000.00 to Complainant, and Complainant releasing Respondent from liability, all as more specifically set forth in the agreement, which is incorporated into this Order by this reference.

The court finds the settlement fair and equitable, and approves it. The court vacates the July 2, 2018, hearing date, and dismisses this action.
