ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT & CANCELLING HEARING

This proceeding arises from a complaint of discrimination filed under the Federal Rail Safety Act (“the FRSA”), 49 U.S.C. § 20109, as amended by Section 1521 of the Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007 (the “9/11 Act”), Pub. L. 110-53, 121 Stat 266 (Aug. 3, 2007).

The above matter is currently scheduled for hearing on October 10, 2019 in New York. However, on September 27, 2019, the Court received a letter from Complainant’s counsel, dated September 20, 2019, advising Complainant would be pursuing her OSHA complaint in U. S. District Court pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 20109(d)(3).

Since the Court no longer has jurisdiction over the instant matter, the claim before the Office of Administrative Law Judges is **DISMISSED**, and the hearing is **CANCELLED**.
