ORDER DISMISSING CASE AS WITHDRAWN

This case arises under the Federal Railroad Safety Act (FRSA), 49 U.S.C. § 20109, and its implementing regulations at 29 C.F.R. Part 1982. After an adverse determination at the Occupational Safety & Health Administration, Complainant requested a hearing before an administrative law judge. The hearing is set for April 21, 2021.

Represented by counsel, on January 28, 2021, Complainant filed a written notice that she is withdrawing her complaint. The withdrawal is APPROVED and this matter is DISMISSED.¹ See 29 C.F.R. § 1982.111(c). The “Secretary’s Findings” that the Occupational Safety & Health Administration issued on May 13, 2020, becomes the final order of the Secretary. *Id.*
