**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW REQUEST
FOR ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING AND DISMISSAL**

This case was previously scheduled to be heard on December 1, 2010, but was held in abeyance, at request of both parties, pending resolution of an ongoing action in state court involving many of the same issues to be adjudicated here. On October 24, 2011, this Office received from counsel for the Solicitor a Notice of Withdrawal of Determination Letter. On the same date, this Office received from counsel for the Respondent a Withdrawal of Request for Administrative Hearing, with an explanation that the matter had been resolved by settlement of a lawsuit in the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit Court of the State of Missouri, cause number 07JE-CC00449. Counsel for the Respondent noted that as a result of the settlement in that matter, the Department of Labor had withdrawn its Letter of Determination, and therefore the Respondent now sought to withdraw its request for an administrative hearing as the issues were now moot and there was no longer a matter in controversy. Accordingly, counsel for the Respondent requested the request for review be withdrawn and the matter be dismissed.

ACCORDINGLY, because there appears to be no controversy left to resolve and the Department of Labor has withdrawn its Determination Letter, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Respondent's request to withdraw its request for an administrative hearing is **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
