ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT

This matter came on for hearing on August 20, 2012. The Solicitor appeared on behalf of *amicus curiae*. Prosecuting Party's counsel appeared and stated on the record that the parties had settled. He presented the parties' proposed settlement agreement for review and approval. It had been signed in counterparts. As nothing further was in dispute, I concluded the hearing.
