**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW
AND DISMISSING CASE**

This matter arises under the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended, 8 U.S.C. §1182(n) and the regulations promulgated thereunder. On 29 Jun 12, the Administrator issued its findings and ordered that Respondent pay back wages and a penalty. On 10 Jul 12, Complainant submitted a letter requesting an administrative hearing for the reason he believed the determination letter was in error.

On 29 Oct 12, pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 18.6(a) Complainant filed a Notice of Withdrawal for the reason the parties reached an agreement resolving the matter and requested the Court approve the notice and dismiss the request for a hearing.

Accordingly, the Complainant's motion to withdraw his appeal is granted and pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 655.815(c)(3), the Administrator's Determination, dated 29 Jun 12, is now a final order of the Secretary of Labor.
