**DECISION AND ORDER**

The Prosecuting Party, the Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor (Administrator), and Respondent, InfoExperts, Inc. (InfoExperts), have negotiated and executed Consent Findings (a copy of which is appended hereto and the recitations of which are deemed to constitute the undersigned's findings and conclusions). These Consent Findings constitute a full and final resolution of this action and of all issues raised by the Determination Letter issued to InfoExperts, Inc. on August 13, 2014 with respect to the employment of eight (8) H-1B nonimmigrant and the H-1B provisions of the Immigration and Naturalization Act (INA), as amended, under 8 U.S.C. § 1182(n) as well as its corresponding regulation requirements at 20 C.F.R. §§ 655.700 *et seq.*

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- (1) That the Consent Findings be and the same hereby are **APPROVED**.
- (2) That the parties be and are bound by the terms of said instrument and shall comply therewith.

Finally, **IT IS HERREBY ORDERED** that the Consent Findings be made part of the record.
