DECISION AND ORDER

Pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 18.71, Rules of Practice and Procedure for Administrative Hearings before the Office of Administrative Law Judges, the parties to this action, the Prosecuting Party, the Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor (“Administrator”), and Camillians Home Health Services, LLC (“Respondent”), have negotiated and executed these Consent Findings (a copy of which is appended hereto and the recitations of which are deemed to constitute any findings and conclusions). These Consent Findings constitute a final and final resolution of this action and of all issues raised by the Determination Letter issued to Respondent on July 26, 2016 (“Determination Letter”) with respect to the employment of one of H-1B nonimmigrants Christian M. Reyes, Maria S. Tiro, Welme J. Bagiuro, and the H-1B provisions of the Immigration and Naturalization Act, as amended, under 8 U.S.C. § 1182(n) as well as its corresponding regulation requirements at 20 C.F.R. §§655.700 *et seq.*

Accordingly, it is ORDERED:

- (1) That the Consent Findings be and the same hereby are APPROVED,
- (2) That the parties be and are bound by the terms of said instrument and shall comply therewith;
and
- (3) That \$145,114.23 be paid by Respondent to the Department of Labor as set forth below as a full and final resolution of this action and of all issues raised by the Determination Letter.

Respondent shall make an initial payment in the amount of \$35,691.14, due on or before March 8, 2017, plus 17 consecutive monthly installments of \$5,995.73 beginning on April 8, 2017, and due on or before, but not later than, the same day of each succeeding month, and the final payment (18th monthly payment) due on or before, but not later than, September 8, 2018 will be in the amount of \$7,495.68.
