**DECISION AND ORDER**  
**DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE**

This is a case brought under the employee protection provisions of the Motor Vehicle and Highway Safety Improvement Act of 2012, Section 31307 of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act, 49 U.S.C. § 30171. This matter was docketed to the Office of Administrative Law Judges ("OALJ") on March 25, 2014 and was assigned to me on April 4, 2014. On April 30, 2014, Complainant submitted correspondence expressing his desire to withdraw his appeal following a successful resolution by the parties.
