**ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

These claims arise under Executive Order ("E.O.") 13495, Nondisplacement of Qualified Workers Under Service Contracts, 74 Fed. Reg. 6103 (Jan. 30, 2009); Secretary's Order 05-2010 (Sep. 2, 2010); and the implementing regulations at 29 C.F.R. Part 9 (2013). Proceedings will be held in a manner consistent with the procedural rules set forth in federal regulations at 29 C.F.R. Part 18. A hearing in this matter was scheduled to commence on July 29, 2015, in Atlanta, Georgia.

On July 8, 2015, counsel for the Solicitor, U. S. Department of Labor, advised that the parties had reached a settlement utilizing mediation. On July 13, 2015, the Settlement Agreement was received by the court for review. Upon review of the Settlement Agreement, I find that its terms are fair, adequate, and reasonable, and do not contravene the public interest.

After review of the Settlement Agreement and the administrative record, this Administrative Law Judge finds that the Settlement Agreement complies with the standards required under the Nondisplacement Of Qualified Workers Under Federal Service Contracts, 29 CFR Part 9, and is approved.

**ORDER**

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED**.
2. This matter is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
