DECISION AND ORDER

APPROVING SETTLEMENT

This case comes under the National Transit Systems Security Act of 2007, 6 U.S.C. § 1142 (enacted as part of The Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007, ("9/11 Act") Public Law No: 110-053. (Aug. 3, 2007)) and was scheduled for hearing in Washington, D.C January 13, 2014. On that date, I received a settlement agreement and a proposed Order.

Considering the totality of the Agreement and its primary provisions, I find that it is fair, adequate, and reasonable. It fully resolves all issues between the Complainant and Respondents without impacting the rights of the parties under the NTSSA.

Further, the settlement supports a finding that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that:

1. The Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED**; and
2. The complaint is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**;
3. The hearing is **CANCELLED**.
