ORDER APPROVING CONSENT DECREE

This case arises under Executive Order 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375; Executive Order 12086; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-1, 60-30; Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. § 793; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-74, 60-30; the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, 38 U.S.C. §§ 4211-4212; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-250, 60-30; and governing regulations

On July 3, 2008, the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs of the United States Department of Labor (Plaintiff) filed an administrative Complaint against Sara Lee Bakery Group d/b/a Earthgrains (Defendant) with the Office of Administrative Law Judges (Office). A Notice of Docketing was issued on July 11, 2008, requiring Defendant to answer the Complaint and the parties to exchange prehearing information within specified time frames. The parties complied with the Notice of Docketing.

On July 6, 2009, the parties filed a Consent Decree and Order. A review of the Consent Decree shows that it is in compliance with 41 C.F.R. § 60-30.13(d) and resolves all issues in this matter.

Therefore, the Consent Decree incorporated by reference is APPROVED and ADOPTED in its entirety.
