**ORDER APPROVING CONSENT DECREE
AND
ORDER CANCELLING SCHEDULED HEARING**

This case arises under Executive Order 11246, as amended by Executive Orders 11375 and 12086; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-1, 60-30; Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; 29 U.S.C. §793; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-74, 60-301; Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, 38 U.S.C. §§ 4211-4212; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-250, 60-30; and governing regulations.

On September 24, 2012, the Parties filed a Joint Motion for an Order on Consent Findings. A review of the Consent Decree shows that it is in compliance with 41 C.F.R. § 60-30.13(b) and that it resolved all pending issues in this matter. This office will retain jurisdiction over this matter for two (2) years in the event of a violation of the Consent Decree.

Accordingly, the Consent Decree incorporated by reference is **APPROVED** and **ADOPTED** in its entirety. The hearing scheduled for November 13, 2012 in Newport News, Virginia is hereby **CANCELLED**.
