ORDER APPROVING COMPROMISE AND STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

Pursuant to the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs: Executive Orders: E.O. 11246; E.O. 11375; E.O. 12086; 41 C.F.R. Part 60-1, 60-30; Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. §793; 41 CFR Part 60-74, 60-30 1; Vietnam ERA Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, 38 USC §§4211 and 4212; 41 C.F.R. Parts 60-250, 60-30, this case involves an action against Cargill Meat Solutions Corp. The parties submitted a notice of compromise and stipulation of dismissal.
