**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On March 8, 2013, the Office of Administrative Law Judges (“OALJ”) received Defendant’s Motion to Cancel the March 15, 2013, Hearing and Dismiss Plaintiff’s Complaints for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction. By order dated March 11, 2013, following a brief telephone conference with counsel, I granted Defendant’s motion to cancel the hearing in part by continuing the hearing until such time as it may either be re-set or canceled, and ordered Plaintiff to respond to Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff’s Complaints for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction by March 18, 2013. On March 18, 2013, OALJ received Plaintiff’s response to Defendant’s motion to dismiss. In that response, Plaintiff agreed to dismissal of the complaints.

Good cause appearing, Plaintiff’s Motion to Cancel the March 15, 2013 Hearing and Dismiss Plaintiff’s Complaints for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, these consolidated matters are **DISMISSED**.
