ORDER STAYING PROCEEDING
PENDING RULING ON MOTIONS

This matter arises under Executive Order 11246 (30 Fed.Reg. 12319), as amended, and associated regulations at 41 C.F.R. Chapter 60, and is not currently set for hearing. Oracle filed a number of motions on October 23, 2018, that are pending.¹ On October 26, 2018, I granted OFCCP's request to extend the time to November 21, 2018, for it to respond to the motions.

On October 31, 2018, OFCCP filed a request to hold a case management conference as soon as practicable and a motion to stay proceedings until it occurs. The motion noted that Oracle opposed the request and contends that the court lacks authority to hear the motion to stay, which appears to be an issue raised in the motions that are currently pending.

With the exception of the pending motions and response, I grant the request to stay all further activity in this matter until resolution of the pending motions. OFCCP must file its reply to the motions no later than November 21, 2018. If the motions are denied, I will schedule a conference with the parties to lift the stay and set hearing dates.
