**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**PER CURIAM.** The Administrator, Office of Foreign Labor Certification, by letter received on October 6, 2008, requests dismissal of the Respondent's June 3, 2008, request for review as moot. Respondent's request for review was of the Administrator's Notice of Debarment, notifying Respondent that he had been debarred from the permanent labor certification program, and that the Department of Labor would not process or accept for processing any application submitted by Respondent under 20 C.F.R. Part 656 for a period of three years.

The Administrator's October 6, 2008, letter states that he has withdrawn the debarment order against Respondent.
