ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arises from the Secretary of Labor's enforcement of H-2A provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101 *et seq.*, as amended, and the implementing regulations set forth at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B, 20 C.F.R. § 655.100 *et seq.* On September 30, 2013, the parties filed a Joint Request for Dismissal, representing that they have executed a Settlement Agreement in which both parties agreed to request a dismissal of this case with prejudice subject to the terms of the agreement.
