**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW APPEAL**  
**AND**  
**ORDER CANCELLING HEARING**

This case arises from a request for review of a Debarment Notice issued by the Administrator of the Office of Foreign Labor Certification against Employer Joel Salgado. By letter dated June 19, 2014, Mr. Salgado requested a hearing in accordance with 20 C.F.R. § 655.182(f)(3). The matter was assigned to me, and a hearing was scheduled for April 13, 2015 in Savannah, Georgia. By letter dated March 16, 2015 (received on March 23, 2015 by facsimile), Mr. Salgado stated “In reference to my upcoming appeal scheduled for April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015. I wish to formally withdraw my appeal and to cancel the hearing.”

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The hearing scheduled for April 13, 2015 is CANCELLED;
2. Mr. Salgado’s motion to withdraw his appeal is GRANTED, and his appeal is DISMISSED; and

3. The Administrator's Notice of Debarment – Final Determination dated May 23, 2014 is reinstated as the final order of the Secretary.
