ORDER OF REMAND
FOR FURTHER PROCESSING

PER CURIAM. On August 6, 2012, the Board received a letter from counsel for the Center Director (“CD”) stating that the CD had concluded that the prevailing wage determination at issue in this matter was inappropriately issued at wage level IV, and should instead be issued at wage level III. Based on this conclusion, the CD requests that the case be remanded to him so that he may issue a new prevailing wage determination.

A copy of the CD's letter was sent to Counsel for the Employer, Analog Devices, Inc., and he raised no objection to the CD's request. Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the appeal in the above-captioned matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice and the matter is **REMANDED** to the CD for processing consistent with the conclusions stated in this order.
