**NOTICE OF ASSIGNMENT AND
DECISION AND ORDER OF REMAND**

This matter was originally assigned to Administrative Law Judge Patrick M. Rosenow on October 30, 2018. Judge Rosenow issued a Notice of Docketing and Briefing schedule on October 30, 2018. On November 1, 2018, Judge Rosenow issued a Corrected Notice of Docketing and Order Setting Briefing Schedule (“November Order”). In that order, Judge Rosenow explained that this matter had been “inadvertently assigned to [him, and] . . . that this case would be reassigned to Judge Paul R. Almanza.” November 1 Order at 1.

I was assigned this case on November 2, 2018, and I received the case file in this matter on November 5, 2018. On November 27, 2018, I received the Center Director’s Motion for Remand (“Motion”). Counsel for Director explained that “[t]he parties have reached an agreement in [this] case and have determined that the Employer’s request for review should be remanded to the National Prevailing Wage Center for review.” Motion at 1. Counsel for the Director also stated that “Employer’s representative was contacted and has no objection to the granting of this motion.” *Id.*

Given the foregoing, I find that good cause warrants remanding this matter. Accordingly, the Director’s request is **GRANTED** and this case is **REMANDED** to the National Prevailing Wage Center for review.
