**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

Complainant, Laurie Becker, on March 15, 2010, filed a Notice of Intent to File Complaint for *De Novo* review pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 1980.114(a), in this claim under the employee protection provisions of Section 806 of Title VIII of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002, 18 U.S.C. Section 1514A. Complainant's Notice states that she would seek *de novo* review of the Assistant Secretary's findings and preliminary order dated January 20, 2010, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin. On April 21, 2010, Complainant submitted a copy of the Complaint she filed in United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin seeking *de novo* review of the Assistant Secretary's findings and preliminary order issued in this matter.
