ORDER DISMISSING CLAIM

This claim arises under Section 806 of the Corporate and Criminal Fraud Accountability Act of 2002 (the “Sarbanes-Oxley Act” or “the Act”) and regulations at 29 C.F.R. Part 1980. This claim, being subject to a stay imposed by the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of New Jersey, in case no. 14-35701-LNP, is not set for hearing.

The court held a telephonic status conference on this claim on June 5, 2018. Paul F. Adams appeared on his own behalf, and Attorney James D. Myers appeared for Respondent. It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that the proceedings before the Bankruptcy Court have concluded with the discharge of the trustee for U.S. Fuel Corporation, this court now dismisses this claim.
