**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

This case arises under the employee-protection provisions of Section 806 of the Corporate and Criminal Fraud Accountability Act of 2002, Title VIII of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002, as amended (“SOX”), 18 U.S.C.A. § 1514A, and its implementing regulations found at 29 CFR Part 1980. After learning that Complainant intended to file a complaint in United States District Court, I directed that a copy of the file-stamped complaint be filed here. On November 23, 2016, Complainant complied with that order.
