**ORDER APPROVING WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTIONS
AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This is a claim under the employee-protection provisions of the Corporate and Criminal Fraud Accountability Act of 2002 (the “Sarbanes-Oxley Act” or “SOX”), 18 U.S.C. §1514A, and regulations at 29 C.F.R. Part 1980. It is currently set for hearing in San Francisco, California, on November 8, 2018.

By letter filed August 29, 2018, the Complainant seeks leave to withdraw his objections to the findings of the Regional Administrator for the Occupational Safety and Health Administration on behalf of the Secretary of Labor issued May 9, 2018. Good cause therefor appearing, I approve the withdrawal of objections under 29 C.F.R. §1980.111, subsection (c). Accordingly,

1. The findings issued May 9, 2018, in this matter comprise the final order of the Secretary of Labor.
