**DECISION AND ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT’S REQUEST TO
WITHDRAW OBJECTIONS TO SECRETARY’S FINDINGS**

This proceeding arises from a complaint of discrimination filed under section 806 of the Corporate and Criminal Fraud Accountability Act of 2002, Title VIII of The Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002, 18 U.S.C.A. § 1514A (West 2004) (hereinafter “SOX”) and the procedural regulations found at 29 C.F.R. Part 1980 (2015). On November 18, 2019, Complainant filed a document entitled: “Letter to Judge.” By way of the Letter, Complainant, a self-represented litigant, seeks to dismiss her complaint without prejudice to litigation she has pending in U.S. District Court. To ensure that she no longer wanted to proceed in this venue, I scheduled Complainant’s request for telephonic hearing on November 27, 2019. During the hearing on the record, Complainant affirmed her request to withdraw this matter and dismiss her complaint pending before me. Upon consideration of the matter, I find that Complainant wishes to voluntarily withdraw her objections to the Secretary’s Findings and end this proceeding. Accordingly it is ORDERED that:

1. Complainant's request to withdraw her objections to the Secretary's findings is GRANTED, without prejudice to any proceeding she has pending in U.S. District Court; and
2. The Assistant Secretary's Findings issued on March 11, 2019 shall be the final order of the Secretary in this matter. 29 C.F.R. §1980.111(c).
