RULING ON COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW

Procedural Background

This matter involves complaints under the whistleblower protection provisions of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act¹ and the regulations promulgated thereto,² brought by Complainant against Respondent. After the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) dismissed his initial complaints, Complainant filed timely

objections and the cases were referred to me. Following an initial scheduling conference, I set the formal hearing for 3 Oct 21. On 2 Nov 20, Complainant filed a motion to withdraw his objections.³ Respondent does not object. Complainant's motion is granted, the hearing date is canceled, and the OSHA findings below are reinstated and will become final.

In view of the foregoing, the hearing scheduled on **21 May 21** in **Dallas, Texas** is hereby **CANCELLED**.
